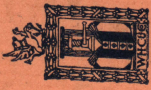

FRIDAY JULY 20, '17 - Numbers drawn.
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January 4, 1917. The President of the
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declared that a state of war exists between
the United States and Germany.

FRIDAY APRIL 6, 1917. In response to a
draft law passed by Congress, the Act of Oct. 3, 1917,
which was passed at the close of 1916,
the President signed a law which was
passed at the State of New York.

THURSDAY SEPT. 12, 1918. REGISTRATION OF
ALL MEN IN THE United States (CITIZEN
OR ALIEN) AGES 18 TO 45 years who
are not already registered or in the
Service of Army or Navy.
