At this point, CURTIS was transported to booking and placed into the BT room where he was informed that he was being recorded. Communication/Booking supervisor, Sgt CATTERALL turned on the video camera and read CURTIS his miranda rights including his statutory rights and consent off of a statutory rights and consent form kept in the BT room.

CURTIS stated that he understood his rights and agreed to answer questions. Sgt. CATTERALL began questioning CURTIS. Refer to NBPD OUI videotape #2B85 and Sgt. CATTERALL's supplement report. CURTIS refused to submit to BT testing. Ofc. LUIS CABRAL witnessed and signed the refusal forms. CURTIS refused to sign any of the printed paperwork.

After refusing the BT. Sgt CATTERALL asked CURTIS if he had anything that he wanted to add while the videotape was still recording in which he stated that he was a little tipsy but he was not a bad guy. I than removed CURTIS from the BT room and proceeded to the general booking area. Curtis was booked, photographed and later transported to NEW BEDFORD HOUSE OF CORRECTIONS by PTI operator, Ofc. LUIS CABRAL.
