As indicated on previously approved permits for this location as well as the sketch provided w/ this permit, final site restoration is as follows:

① 5.5' cem. conc. sidewalks w/ grass ribbon along north side of Wood St

② R#3 granite curb along east side of Bellville Ave for extent of work to abandon existing vault. loam and seed sidewalk area

③ Install ADA compliant chevron ramps at northwest and southeast corners of the intersection. DPI to install southwest and south east corners.

④ Final paving to be curb to curb for extents of the trench work and including the intersection. Traffic loops to be replaced/removed by Eversource due to damage as a result of gas work.
