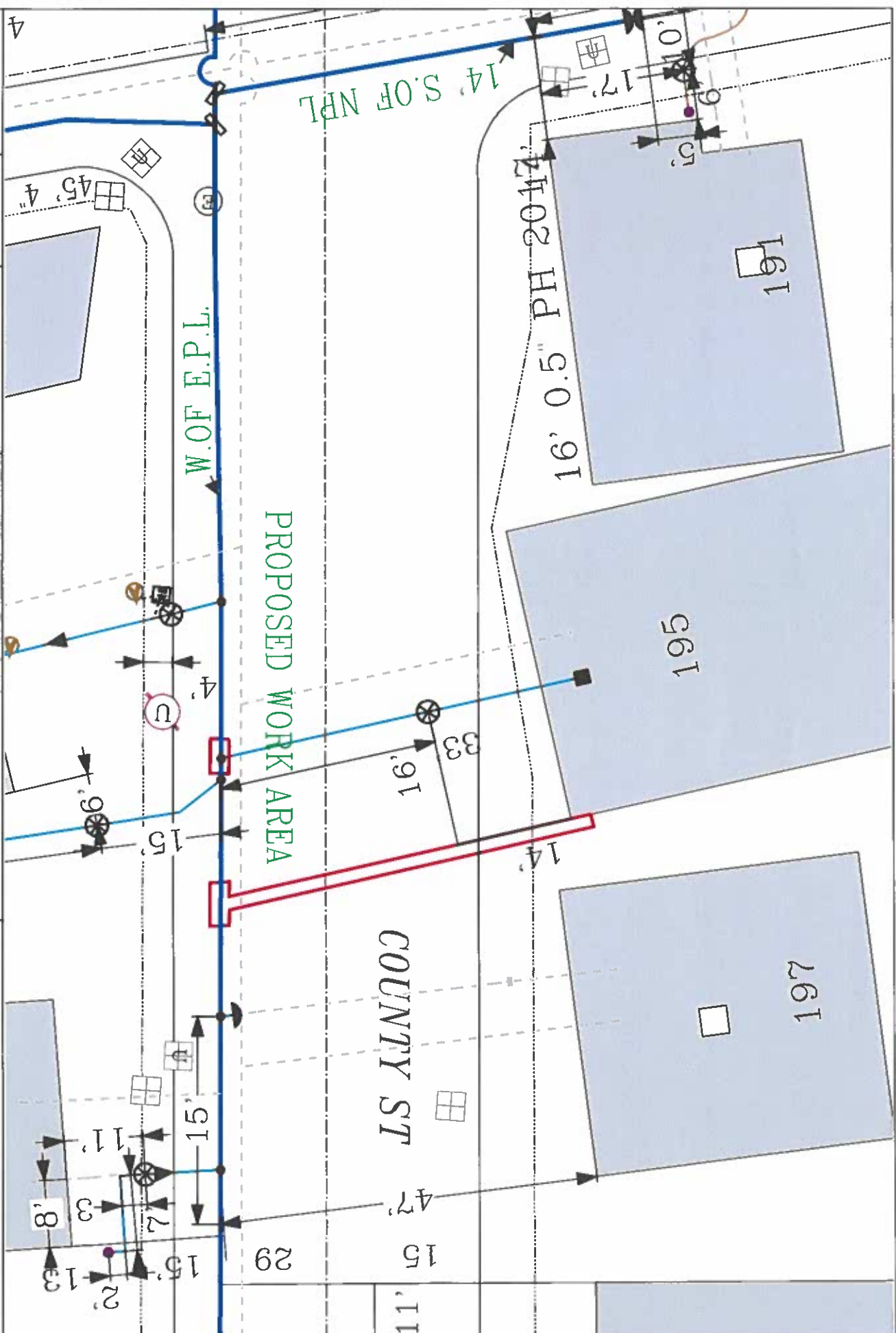
Final Trench Restoration: Final patch to be one large patch that includes new service install and cut and cap service. Not to be two separate patches
