EASEMENT

I, Florence Gardner of New Bedford within the County of Bristol and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, for consideration paid, grant to William W. Piche and Shirley A. Piche, and his heirs, successors and assigns, the perpetual right and easement to erect, lay out, maintain and enter upon for the purposes of repair, pipes, conduits and water meter for sewers and water lines under the land of the grantor. Said easement is located on the westerly boundary of the land of the grantor and for a width of ten (10) feet and extends from the north side of Osgood Street 80 feet in a northerly direction to the southerly boundary of the land of the grantee. The land covered by the within easement is described in a deed to the grantor in Bristol County S. D. Registry of Deeds, Certificate Number 4847-Registered land being dated May 10, 1951.

It is agreed that the pipes, conduits and water meter shall be and remain the property of the grantee and the installation and maintenance and repairs shall be at the sole expense of the grantee.

It is further agreed that the grantee, his heirs, successors and assigns shall be obligated to restore the land to the same grade, condition and level.
