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
NOTICE OF SEWER AGREEMENT

In consideration of the City of New Bedford permitting Mikene Realty Trust, Arnold R. Briden, Trustee of 190 William Street, New Bedford, to make a connection to a public sewer, the said parties hereto and their heirs and assigns, being owners of the property located on the east side of Alex Street in New Bedford and which is described more specifically in a "subdivision of land in New Bedford, Massachusetts belonging to Mikene Realty Trust", recorded in the Bristol County (S.D.) Registry of Deeds as Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, on said plan as two of which lots shall contain a four-plex for a total of 3 four-plexes; and the said Mikene Realty Trust, Arnold R. Briden, Trustee and subsequent purchasers thereof, and their heirs and assigns, do hereby agree to bear jointly the cost of the sewer drains serving the above described property from the point where said sewer drains combine into a single pipe to the point where said single pipe enters into the public sewer on Grape Street.

The above described statement effects land as described in a deed from Gordon S. Hopkins to Arnold R. Briden, Trustee, recorded in the Bristol County (S.D.) Registry of Deeds.

All future conveyances by the said Mikene Realty Trust, Arnold R. Briden, Trustee shall be subject to this agreement.



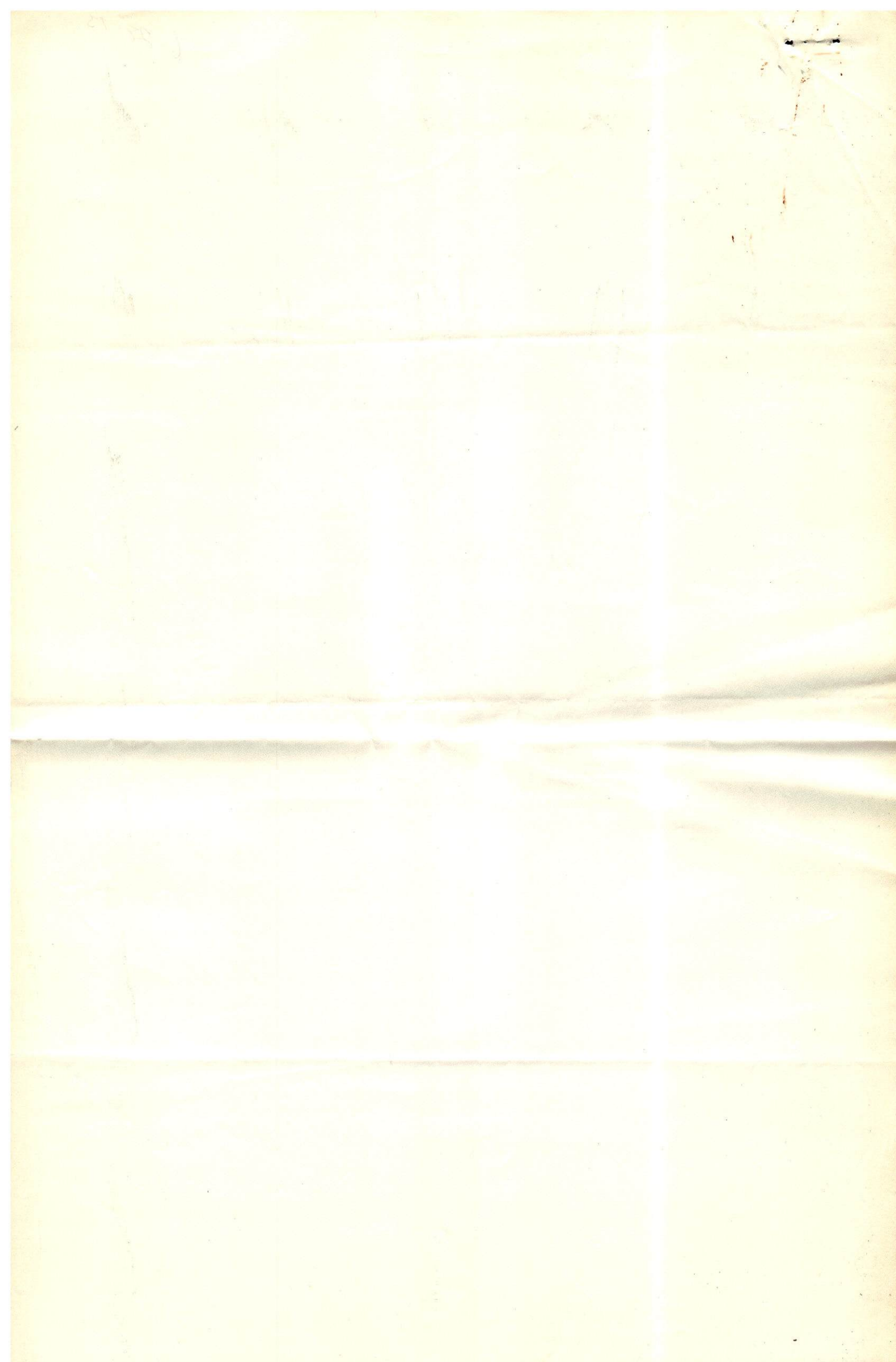
