REGISTERED LANDGrant of an Easement

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, John Jerome, of 88 Winterville Road, New Bedford, Bristol County, Massachusetts, married to Lena Jerome, for the consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) grant to Luis Alberto Furtado and Salome Sousa Furtado, husband and wife, of 45 Schofield Street, in said New Bedford, as joint tenants and not as tenants by the entirety, a perpetual easement to install and maintain a sewer pipe for the benefit of their land located on the north side of Schofield Street, and shown as Lot 45 on plan hereinafter referred to, connecting the same to the public sewer located in Winterville Road, said easement being described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the northerly line of Winterville Road at a point 29 feet easterly from the drill hole at the southwest corner of Lot 18 on Plan of Land No. 6586A drawn by Albert B. Drake, C.E. dated July 30, 1917 and filed in Land Registration Office at Boston, Massachusetts, a copy of which is filed in Bristol County (S.D.) Registry of Deeds in Land Registration Book 4, Page 177, with Certificate of Title No. 874;

thence running easterly 15.50 feet in said line of Winterville Road to the southeast corner of said Lot 18;

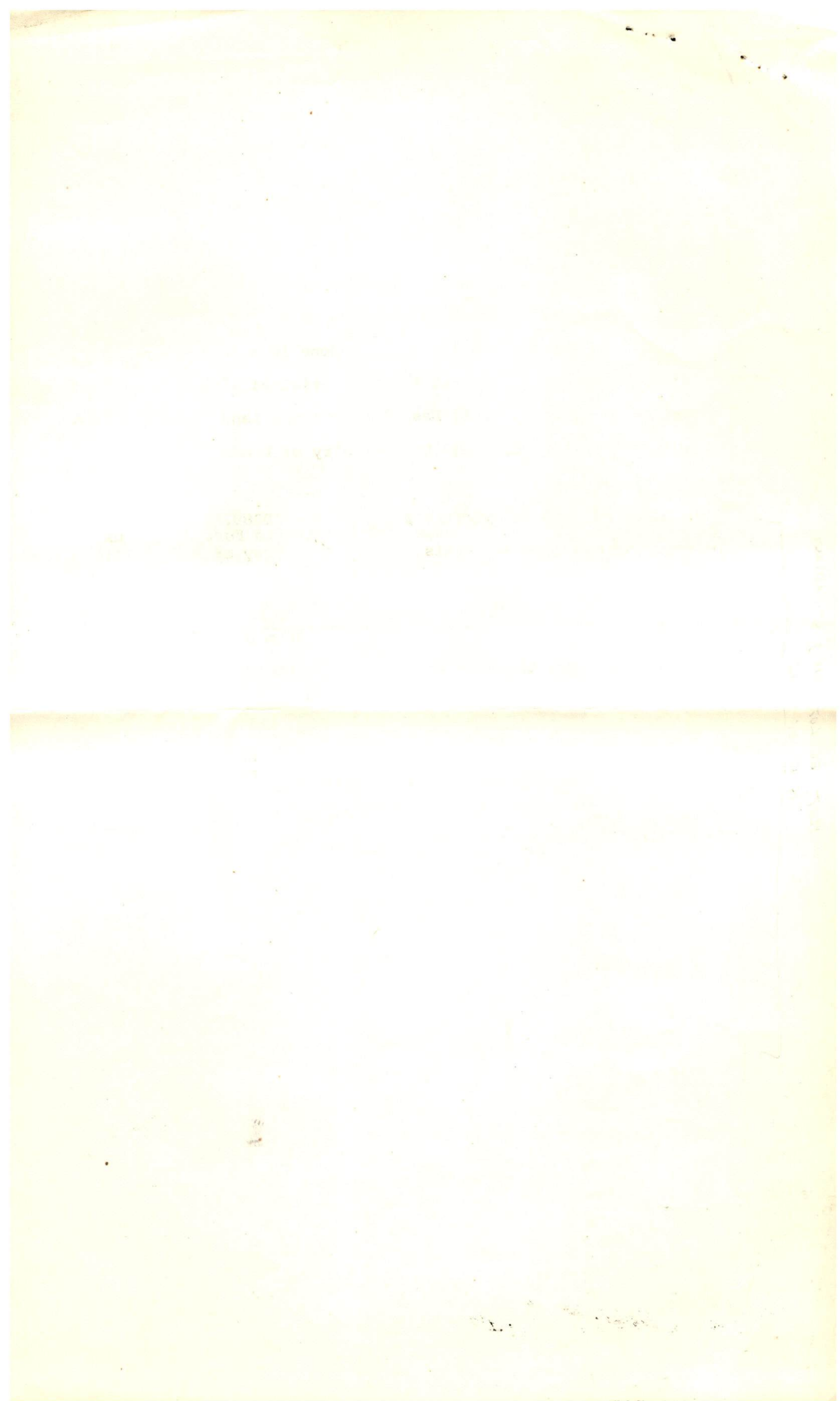
thence northerly in the easterly line of said Lot 18 and the easterly line of Lot 19, 112.50 feet to the northeast corner of said Lot 19 and the southerly line of Schofield Street;

thence running westerly in the said southerly line of Schofield Street and the northerly line of said Lot 19, 15 feet;

thence turning and running southerly through Lot 19 and Lot 18, 122 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.

Said Easement to permit the Grantees, their heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, to enter on such Easement for the purpose of installing and maintaining sewer pipes at their sole cost and expense, and provided further that said Grantees, their heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns covenant and agree to cause all trenches or other excavations dug upon said Lots 18 and 19 to be covered within forty-eight (48) hours of such digging and that all work done on said Lots 18 and 19 shall be done in a good and workmanlike manner with all surfaces restored to their original grade and condition.

Grantees by recording this Easement with the Land Registration Records of the Bristol County (S.D.) Registry of Deeds, accept the terms of this Easement.
