AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CITY CHARTER
IN RELATION TO THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN
BEFORE THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN
ON THE 11th DAY OF NOVEMBER, 1977
THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF NEW BEDFORD, MASSACHUSETTS, DO HEREBY RESOLVE:
That the City Charter be amended to read as follows:
Section 1. The Board of Aldermen shall consist of nine members, each elected for a term of three years.
Section 2. The Board of Aldermen shall meet on the first Monday of each month, except in the month of July, when the meeting shall be held on the first Tuesday.
Section 3. The Board of Aldermen shall have the honor and privilege of the City Seal.
Section 4. The Board of Aldermen shall have the right to call and receive the Mayor and the City Clerk at any time.
Section 5. The Board of Aldermen shall have the right to call and receive the Mayor and the City Clerk at any time.
