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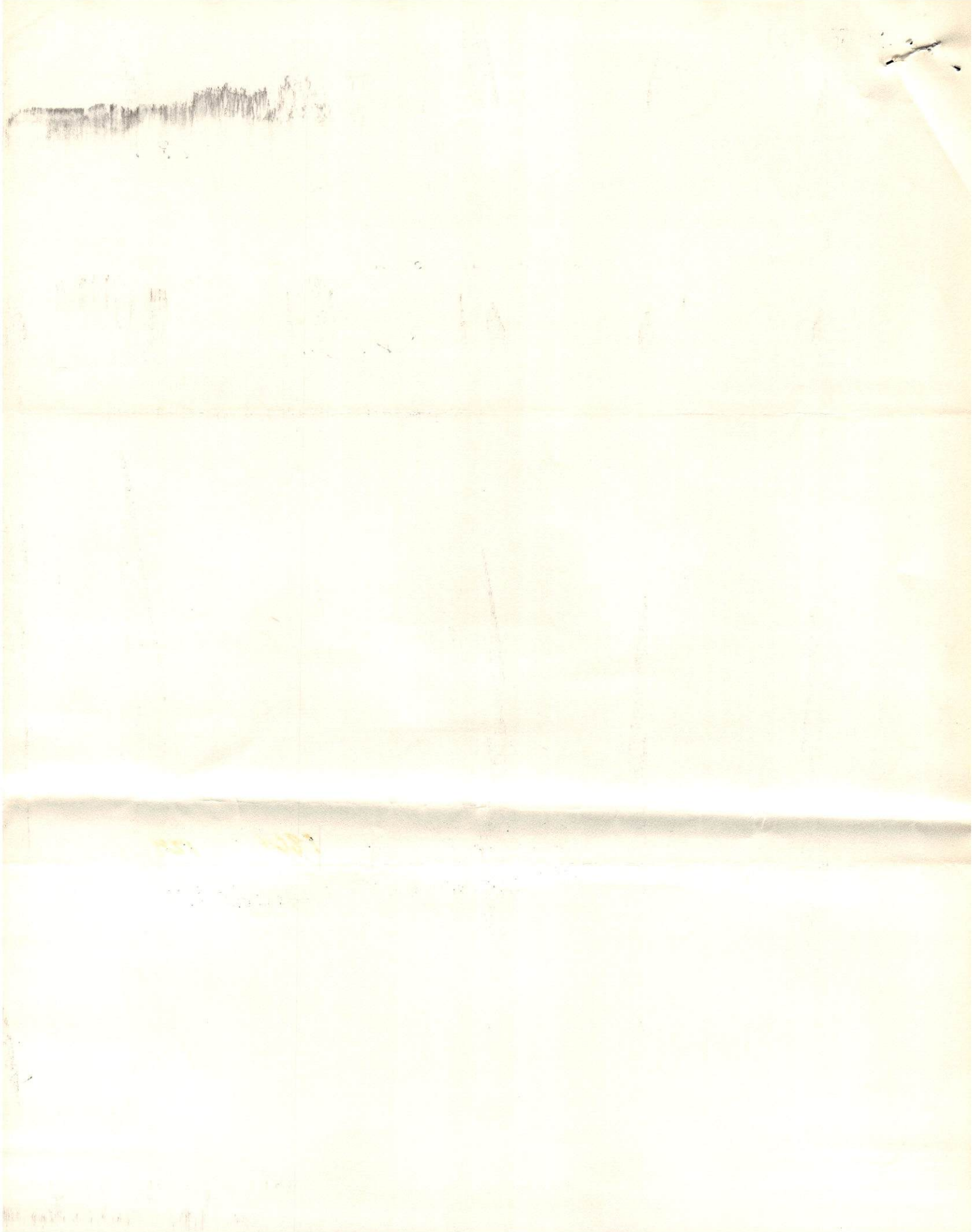

Pacheco, husband and wife, both of 255 Shaw Street, New Bedford, Massachusetts, to make connection to a public sewer, the said parties hereto, their heirs and/or assigns, being owners of property located at the end of Winston Street in the City of New Bedford and extending into the Town of Acushnet, and being the owners of Lots #43, 43A & 46 on Plat 18 of the Acushnet Assessor's, said property also being described in a deed of Peckham Realty Corporation to the said Hermano S. Medeiros, Maria F. Medeiros, Jose M. Pacheco and Maria J. Pacheco, dated February 14, 1980, and recorded in Book 1800, Page 274, in the Bristol County (S.D.) Registry of Deeds, and also being shown as Parcels 1 and 2 on a Plan of Land entitled "Green Acres Subdivision of Land in Acushnet" recorded in said Registry of Deeds in Plan Book 103, Page 71, do hereby agree to bear jointly the cost of maintaining the private sewer serving the above described properties, from the point where the individual building sewers combine into a single pipe to the point where said single pipe enters into the public sewer. However, in cases in which the location requiring maintenance is found to be behind or above the point of connection of one or more of the above described individual building sewers, the cost shall be borne jointly by those remaining property owners which have joint use of the private sewer at such location.
