
The purpose of this letter is to make the following assurances to the City of New Bedford, Dept. of Public Works relative to process wastewater discharges to the public sewer system.

As a result of a meeting held in the offices of the Dept. of Public Works on January 8, 1981 the M. F. Foley Co. herewith assures that:

1. All process drain line recessed drain covers will be permanently affixed to the bottom of the drain line with anti-vandal screws.
2. The outside permanent screen-in-manhole facility as shown on plans dated 13 November 1980 and entitled Site Utility Plan S-1 will be installed as shown. Also that all operation and maintenance within the bounds of private property whatsoever involved herewith shall be the sole responsibility of the M. F. Foley Co., Inc.

It is likewise understood and agreed that any problems associated herewith which involve any efforts by the New Bedford Dept. of Public Works shall result in the installation of a basket-in-basket gurry trap within the facilities of the plant above described. Said installation, operation and maintenance shall be the full and complete responsibility of the M.F. Foley Co., Inc.
