Dear Mr. Brightman:

In reference to your request for supplementary information dated January 11, 1982, please be advised of the following:

1. Anticipated daily water usage will be 36,000 GPD, of which as much as 10,000 GPD will be used for cooling purposes in evaporative condensers, and the balance discharged to the sewer.
2. Wastewater pretreatment, as indicated on the attached plan A-1 (revised) will consist of a "Roto-Sieve" separator to remove solids from drain water taken from troughs under processing equipment. The water then passes into underfloor drains and passes through a basket strainer with all other floor drain water before leaving the building.
3. The "cleanout" shown on the plan will consist of a stainless steel perforated strainer basket approximately 24" x 24" x 18" deep, designed to remove any process solids from drain water before it leaves the building.
4. The internal piping plan has been updated to show all current revisions.

Please advise if additional information is needed.
