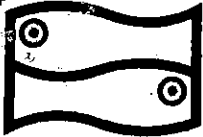

It has come to our attention that an error was made in the Supplementary Information statement we filed with you on July 23, 1982.

Specifically, item 8, volume of water to be used per day, was estimated at 1,000 gallons. This is now revised to 39,600 gallons per day. Item 17, volume of wastewater discharged daily was estimated at 750 gallons, but should now read 36,000 gallons.
