THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES, created by Chapter 1000 of the Laws of 1962, is a new and dynamic agency. It is the largest and most complex of the State's executive departments, and its operations are the most extensive and varied. The Department is responsible for the administration of the State's social service programs, including the Family Court, the State Office of Mental Health, the State Office of Child Welfare, the State Office of Social Services, and the State Office of Family Services. The Department's budget for 1964 is \$1.2 billion, and it employs over 10,000 personnel.
