

Dear Sir:

On Friday, May 23, 1986, your company installed sewer and storm drain connections to the City mains on Emma Street from property located at 780 Brock Ave., owned by Interchurch Elderly Housing of 412 County St. This work was authorized by Sewer/Drain Permit #21022. One of the terms of this Permit is the requirement of inspection of the installation by a City D.P.W. Inspector.

On the date in question, Inspector Lawrence Worden of this Department visited the job site at approximately 11:45 a.m., and found the work partially finished but not yet ready for inspection and final measurement. Mr. Worden left a copy of the City specifications with the crew and promised to return later for the inspection.

When he returned at 3:00 p.m., he found the pipe buried, and backfilling in progress. After some discussion concerning several points of the installation, Mr. George Regis, foreman on the job, was told that the pipe installation still had to be inspected and measurements made, and he was asked to have the pipe uncovered. Mr. Regis at first agreed, then apparantly changed his mind and refused, offering as reasons "too much trouble", he "didn't think the inspector was coming back", his boss "told me to backfill", etc. Asked a second time if he was refusing to comply with the inspector's directive, he replied "Yes".

Upon receipt of the report of Mr. Regis' refusal to abide by the inspection requirements, Mr. Bill Boucher of this office called your main office by phone in the presence of Mr. Worden and Mr. Leon Halle, Chief Engineer for the City. He explained the requirement and again ordered that the installation be re-dug for the inspection and measurement. To date, no further word has been received from you concerning this matter.

In view of this attitude and refusal to comply with the regulations governing such installations, please be advised of the following:

1. The name of John H. Fellouris, Inc., has been removed from the list of contractors eligible for work on City streets and ways:

2. A Certificate of Occupancy request for the premises served by

the connection will be refused by this Department;

3. Unless you make the necessary arrangements with this office to uncover the work and have the inspection and measurements made and the results thereof recorded by the close of the business day June 20, 1986, at your expense, the City will perform the excavation and inspection, and all expenses connected therewith will be billed directly to your Bonding Co.

It is suggested that you attend to this matter promptly.



Dear Sir:

In response to your letter of February 18, 1986 to Bill Boucher of this Department re: Storm Water Disposal at 790 Brock Avenue, be advised that due to lack of practical alternatives, the City will accept storm water discharged from the above-referenced premises into the sewer in Emma Street as per your drawings.

However, in consideration of the above, should a separate storm drain facility become available to the property at a future date, the storm drain connection requested above shall be removed from the sanitary sewer and connected to said storm drain facility at the expense of the property owner.

All required permits for the above work must be secured before any connections can be allowed.





Dear Bill:

Our firm has been retained by the architect for the above project, Schwartz/Silver Architects, Boston, MA. to prepare the Plumbing and Fire Protection Design for said project which is located on the northeast corner of the intersection of Brock Avenue and Emma Street.


The proposed project is a rehabilitation of an existing building. Further, the existing building contains a flat roof which had roof drains connecting to the sanitary piping. In essence, the sanitary drain was conveying both sanitary waste and rain water in the same pipe.


As per the State Plumbing Code, since completely new systems are being installed, it is necessary to provide separate sanitary and storm drains to a point 10 ft. outside the building, which separation is shown on our drawings.

There exists in the vicinity of the project only combined sewers and, therefore, no separate storm drain connection is feasible.

The site is very small and there is no reasonable amount of land which could be used for on-site percolation of the rain water.

The only feasible alternative, therefore, is to connect the storm drainage to the combined sewer under Emma Street.
