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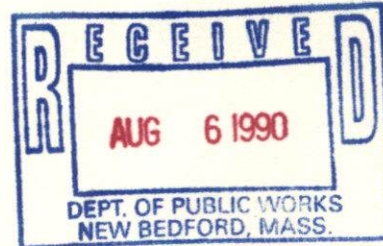

said service was installed as our building service under the provisions of the city code. It was paid for entirely by us as our private line. It is protected by the terms of the joint maintenance agreement recorded at Bristol County (S.D.) Registry of Deeds dated October 10, 1986, Book 1989 Page 1072, which document defines the private and exclusive nature of this service and was required by the city as a condition of permit issuance.

We as owners wish to retain our right of private ownership and oppose any attempt to introduce further connections to this line or the appropriation of the line by any one else.
