- e) Other requirements: INSPECTION ONLY - SEWER & STORM CONNECTION

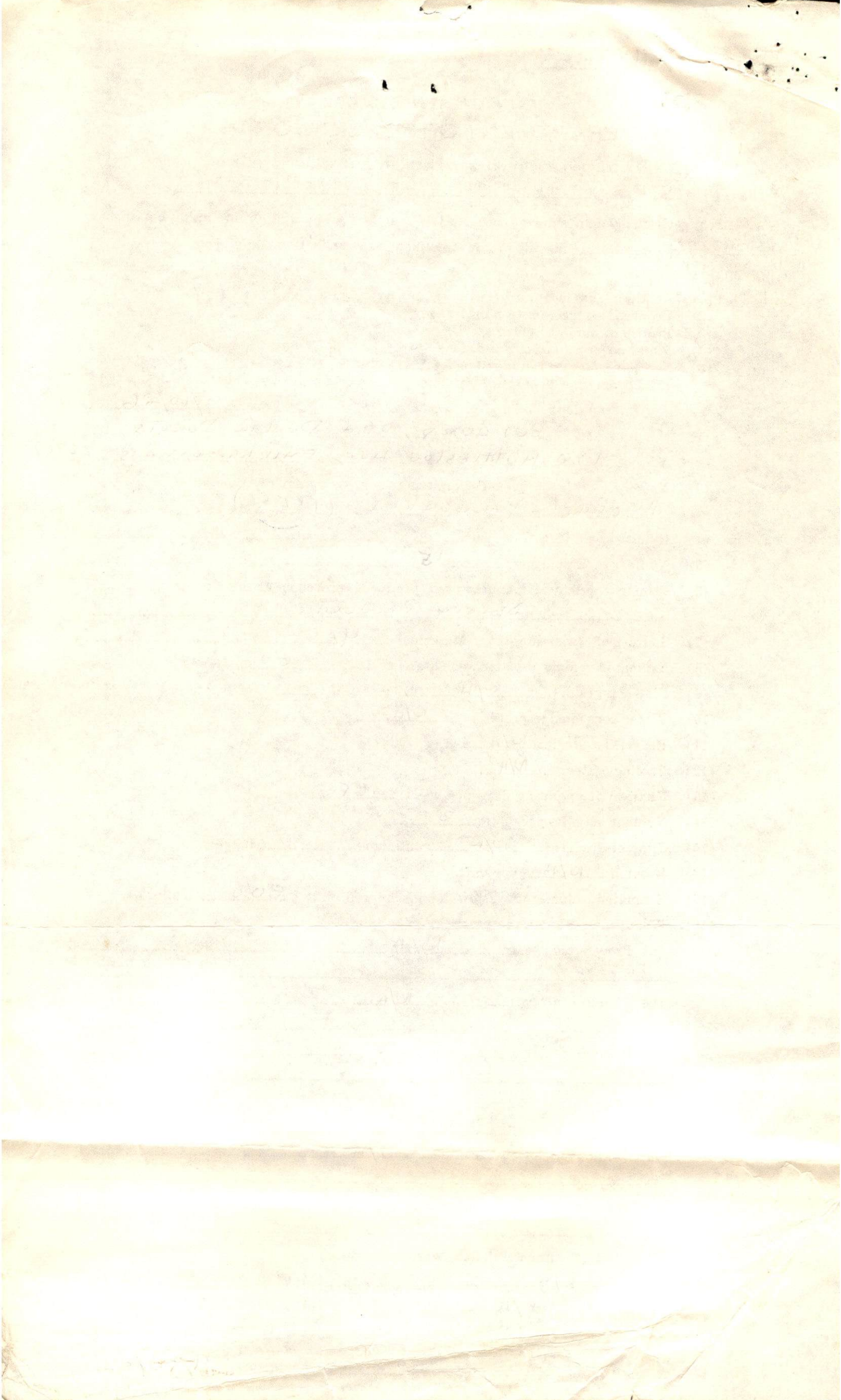

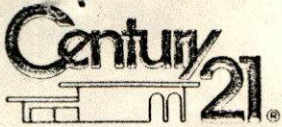

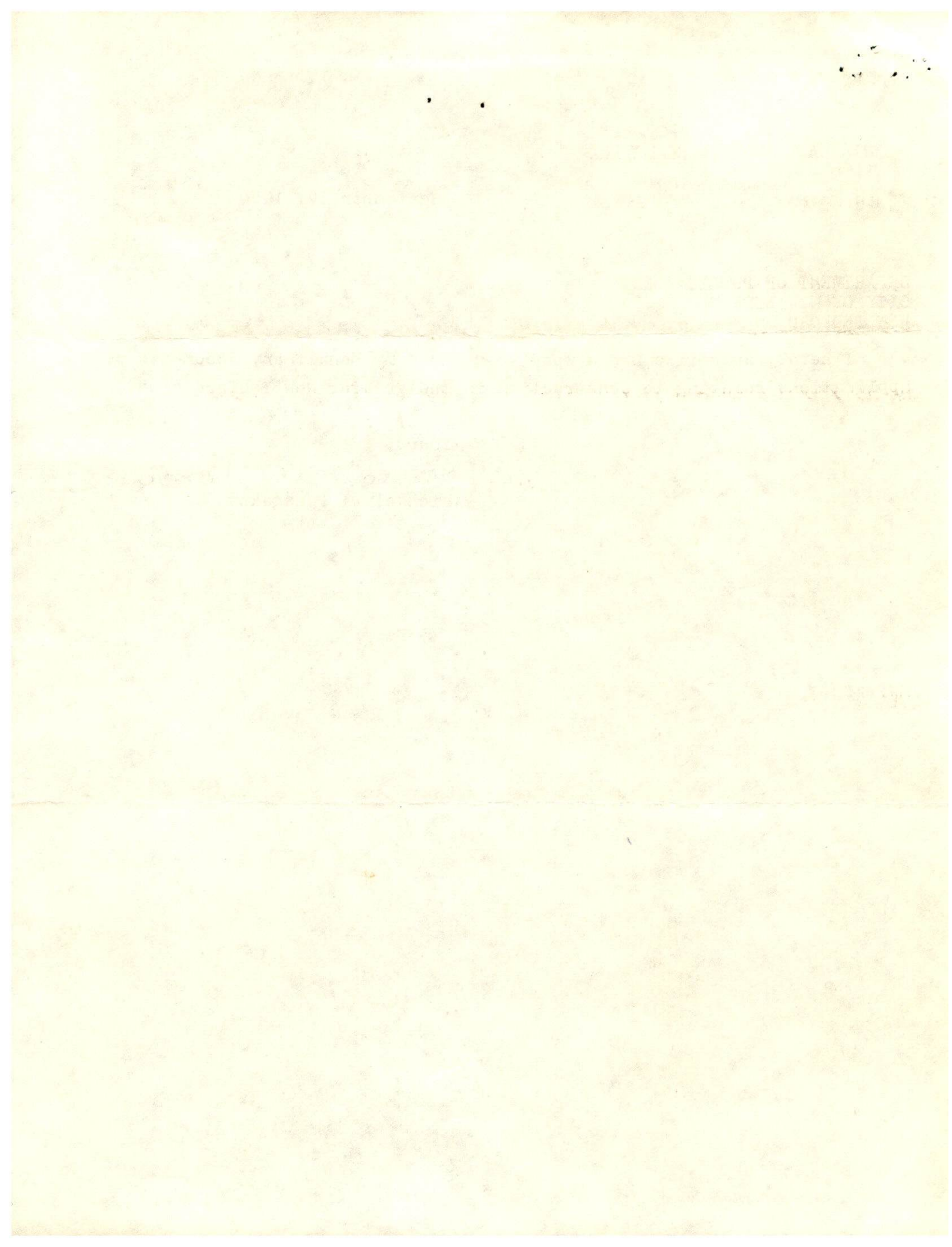
