## AGREEMENT

AGREEMENT made this 26th day of October , 1986, by and between HAROLD S. BOSWORTH and JEAN H. BOSWORTH, husband and wife, jointly and severally, both of 60 Prospect Street, South Dartmouth, Massachusetts, hereinafter called BOSWORTHS, and JOHN DE MELLO, of 46 Sagamore Street, New Bedford, Massachusetts, hereinafter called DE MELLO. This AGREEMENT is to be binding on the heirs, executors, administrators and assigns of the parties hereto wherever the context so admits.

WHEREAS, the BOSWORTHS have installed a sewer service to certain property owned by them and have entered into an Agreement with the City of New Bedford, said Agreement being recorded in the Bristol County (S.D.) Registry of Deeds, Book 1720, Page 475; and

WHEREAS, DE MELLO owns property located on Osborne Street which could be served by the aforementioned water main pipe and sewer line, said lot being number 69.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the said DE MELLO paying the said BOSWORTHS the sum of One Thousand (\$1,000)

Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said BOSWORTHS do hereby grant to the said DE MELLO the right to make two connections into the sewer line referred to in the Agreement recorded in Bristol County (S.D.) Registry of Deeds, in Book 1720, Page 475.

In addition, in consideration of the City of New Bedford permitting JOHN DE MELLO to make connection to a public sewer, the said parties hereto, their heirs, and/or assigns being owners of property located at Osborne Street, New Bedford, Massachusetts, Plat 17, Lot 69, do hereby agree to bear jointly the cost of maintaining a private sewer serving the above-described properties from the point where the individual building sewers combine into a single pipe to the point where said single pipe enters into the public sewer. However, in cases in which the location requiring maintenance is found to be behind or above the point of connection of one or more of the above-described individual building sewers, the cost shall be borne jointly by those remaining property owners which have joint use of the private sewer at such location.
