- d) A Filing and Inspection Fee of \$ 50.00, plus an Entrance Fee of \$ where applicable, must accompany this application.
- e) Other requirements: Insp. only

AGREEMENT

AGREEMENT made this 14th day of September, 1987 by and between HAROLD S. BOSWORTH, of 60 Prospect Street, Dartmouth, Massachusetts, hereinafter called BOSWORTH, and ARCELINO SILVEIRA and MARIA A. SILVEIRA, husband and wife, of 190 Hemlock Street, New Bedford, Massachusetts, hereinafter called SILVEIRA. This Agreement is to be binding on the heirs, executors, administrators and assigns of the parties hereto wherever the context so admits.

WHEREAS, BOSWORTH has installed a sewer service to certain property owned by him and has entered into an Agreement with the City of New Bedford, said Agreement being recorded in the Bristol County S. D. Registry of Deeds, Book 1720, Page 475; and

WHEREAS, SILVEIRA owns property located on Osborne Street which could be served by the aforementioned water main pipe and sewer line, said lots being numbers 79 and 80;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the said SILVEIRA paying the said BOSWORTH the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000), the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said BOSWORTH does hereby grant to the said SILVEIRA the right to make two connections into the sewer line referred to in the Agreement recorded in the Bristol County S. D. Registry of Deeds in Book 1720, Page 475.

In addition, in consideration of the City of New Bedford permitting SILVEIRA to make connection to a public sewer, the said parties hereto, their heirs, and/or assigns, being owners of property located at Osborne Street, New Bedford, Massachusetts, Plat 17, Lots 79 and 80, do hereby agree to bear jointly

the cost of maintaining a private sewer serving the above described properties from the point where the individual building sewers combine into a single pipe to the point where said single pipe enters into the public sewer. However, in cases in which the location requiring maintenance is found to be behind or above the point of connection of one or more of the above described individual building sewers, the cost shall be borne jointly by those remaining property owners which have joint use of the private sewer at such location.


