In addition, a valid Industrial User Discharge Permit issued by the City, and a valid Permit for Sewer System Extension or Connection issued by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, Division of Water Pollution Control, shall be required for applicants wishing to discharge industrial wastes to the City's sewer system.

TERMS

- a) Type of Pipe Required: PVC SDR-35
- b) Separate Sanitary and Storm connections are required where a 2 - pipe system exists in the street.
- c) All work must be inspected and approved by a D.P.W. Inspector, both in the street and on private property, before backfilling.
- d) A Filing and Inspection Fee of \$ 50.00, plus an Entrance Fee of \$ where applicable, must accompany this application.
- e) Other requirements: Insp. only - connect to private line in street - Joe August to do all work

Applicant agrees to abide by the above terms, as well as all pertinent ordinances of the City of New Bedford, and such other special rules as the Commissioner of Public Works may deem necessary.

AGREEMENT

AGREEMENT made this 31st day of August, 1988, by and between HAROLD S. BOSWORTH, of 60 Prospect Street, Dartmouth, Massachusetts, hereinafter called BOSWORTH, and AMARO CABRAL and ANNA CABRAL, husband and wife, of 19 Thatcher Street, New Bedford, Massachusetts, hereinafter call CABRAL. This Agreement is to be binding on the heirs, executors, administrators and assigns of the parties hereto wherever the context so admits.

WHEREAS, BOSWORTH has installed a sewer service to certain property owned by him and has entered into an Agreement with the City of New Bedford, said Agreement being recorded in the Bristol County S.D. Registry of Deeds, Book 1720, Page 475; and

WHEREAS, CABRAL owns property located on Osborne Street which could be served by the aforementioned water main pipe and sewer line, said lot being number 83;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the said CABRAL paying the said BOSWORTH the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000), the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said BOSWORTH does hereby grant to the said CABRAL the right to make two connections into the sewer line referred to in the Agreement recorded in the Bristol County S.D. Registry of Deeds in Book 1720, Page 475.

In addition, in consideration of the City of New Bedford permitting CABRAL to make connection to a public sewer, the said parties hereto, their heirs, and/or assigns, being owners of property located at Osborne Street, New Bedford, Massachusetts, Plat 17, Lot 83, do hereby agree to bear jointly

the cost of maintaining a private sewer serving the above described properties from the point where the individual building sewers combine into a single pipe to the point where said single pipe enters into the public sewer. However, in cases in which the location requiring maintenance is found to be behind or above the point of connection of one or more of the above described individual building sewers, the cost shall be borne jointly by those remaining property owners which have joint use of the private sewer at such location.


