

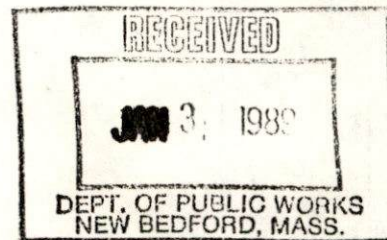

Dear Ms. Burns:

The Environmental Protection Agency has received and reviewed your October 18, 1988 request for approval of the tie-in of the Astra Corporation to the New Bedford sewer system. In accordance with paragraph V.K.7 of the Consent Decree and where Astra's intended industrial processes will be dry processes, we hereby approve the tie-in of that facility.

It is our recommendation, however, that although the City does not plan to issue a pretreatment permit to Astra, it should complete a thorough inspection of Astra's facility to verify information provided to the City on Astra's permit application. In particular, the City should inspect manufacturing process areas, chemical and waste storage areas, spill prevention and control procedures, and all areas with floor drains. The City should also request a scale drawing of Astra's plant site.

This letter is to confirm that the 8" sewer service from the Astra Corporation was connected to the City of New Bedford sewer system.

The work was completed on January 18, 1989 by D.W. White Cons., Inc., 867 Middle Road, Acushnet Mass.

I inspected the pipe installation from an existing stub at the property line, to ten (10) feet from the building, including a control man-hole which was installed just inside the property line.

All work was found to meet City of New Bedford requirements. For future reference the Sewer Permit number is 21775.
