In addition, a valid Industrial User Discharge Permit issued by the City, and a valid Permit for Sewer System Extension or Connection issued by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, Division of Water Pollution Control, shall be required for applicants wishing to discharge industrial wastes to the City's sewer system.

a) Type of Pipe Required: PVC SDR-35

b) Separate Sanitary and Storm connections are required where a 2 - pipe system exists in the street.

c) All work must be inspected and approved by a D.P.W. Inspector, both in the street and on private property, before backfilling.

d) A Filing and Inspection Fee of \$ 100.00 ..., plus an Entrance Fee of \$... where applicable, must accompany this application.

e) Other requirements: CLASP only - Part of Joint System - to replace Permit # 20920 used in error for this lot. 20920 to be used for lot 807

Applicant agrees to abide by the above terms, as well as all pertinent ordinances of the City of New Bedford, and such other special rules as the Commissioner of Public Works may deem necessary.

AVERY STREET SEWER PERMITS

- 1.) Lots 803 & 807 on Assessor's Plat 130-B, south side Avery St., both erroneously shown on D.P.W. records as being owned by Beatrice Mendes in 1984.
- 2.) Sewer permit #20920 issued to Mendes for "a lot west of Wildwood Road" in 1985. Joint Maintenance Agreement also issued to cover both lots.
- 3.) Ownership record corrected at some time after (2) above.
- 4.) Lot 803 passes thru several changes of ownership, owner Rob't Long builds house, uses permit #20920 for sewer connection.
- 5.) Error and correction listed in (1) and (3) come to light in 1991 when Mendes signifies intent to build on lot 807 using "her" permit (20920)
- 6.) New sewer permit #22067 issued 5/6/91 for lot 803 (to replace #20920) in name of Paul J. Hebert, who was the owner in 1984, and whose name was inserted in record card per (3) above. His name also appears on Joint Maintenance Agreement.
- 7.) Original permit #20920 now to be used by Mendes for lot 807.
