In addition, a valid Industrial User Discharge Permit issued by the City, and a valid Permit for Sewer System Extension or Connection issued by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, Division of Water Pollution Control, shall be required for applicants wishing to discharge industrial wastes to the City's sewer system.

a) Type of Pipe Required: PVC ODR-35

b) Separate Sanitary and Storm connections are required where a 2 - pipe system exists in the street.

c) All work must be inspected and approved by a D.P.W. Inspector, both in the street and on private property, before backfilling.

d) A Filing and Inspection Fee of \$ 150.00, plus an Entrance Fee of \$ where applicable, must accompany this application.

e) Other requirements: Cruz Const. to do all work tie in to a 24" sewer pipe on Lynn St.

Applicant agrees to abide by the above terms, as well as all pertinent ordinances of the City of New Bedford, and such other special rules as the Commissioner of Public Works may deem necessary.

Dear Mr. Rodriques:

A dye test of the waste discharge pipe from your property was made by representatives of the D.P.W. and Health Dept. on December 16, 1992.

Results of the test proved that your service is in fact connected to the North End Relief Interceptor in Lynn St. Although the connection appears to have been properly made, no permit was ever obtained from this office, as required by the City Code.

You are therefore requested to secure such a permit from the City Engineer's Office, room 303, City Hall, within the next 30 days. Permit fee is \$150.00, payable with the application.

Dear Mr. Rodriques:

The New Bedford Board of Health, at its regularly scheduled meeting of October 20, 1992 considered your request for an appeal of the orders set forth in the violation notice dated September 28, 1992.

After careful review of all the evidence presented, the New Bedford Board of Health voted unanimously to modify the provisions of the original order as follows:

1. Application for a sewer entrance permit must be made at the office of the New Bedford Department of Public Works. This will determine if connection to the municipal sewage system is a viable option.

2. The services of an engineer must be secured to determine if:

- a. the septic system has been illegally directed towards the street and/or,

- b. connected to an existing leaching field located on your property at 195 Worcester St.  
Note: The examination of the septic system must be done in the presence of Health Department personnel.

This matter will be placed on the agenda of the next Board of Health meeting which is scheduled for December 1, 1992. At that time you will be asked to present this information to the Board.

Any person aggrieved by the final decision of the Board of Health may appeal the decision to a court of competent jurisdiction.

Dear Mr. Rodriques:

Acting under the authority of 310 CMR 11.03, Title I of the Environmental Code, William Blackburn as agent of the New Bedford Health Department, examined the sewage disposal facilities on your property at 195 Worcester Street (see attached report).

At that time, you advised Mr. Blackburn that your house is currently connected to an individual sewage disposal system. Some time in the recent past, approximately six (6) years ago, your septic tank was directly connected to the crushed stone bed which surrounds the municipal sewer system.

Please be advise that this arrangement is illegal and in violation of the general requirements of Title 5, State Environmental Code, 310 CMR 15.02.

In addition, due to the illegal disposal system, your house currently is not provided with a proper means of sewage disposal. As such, you are in violation of Article II, State Sanitary Code: Minimum Standards of Fitness for Human Habitation, 105 CMR 410.300.


As a result, you are hereby notified to comply with the following conditions by not later than the dates accompanying each:

- 1) Within seven (7) days of receipt of this notice a sewer entrance permit to tie into the abutting municipal sewage system to be obtained from New Bedford Department of Public Works.
- 2) Within (30) days of issuance of the sewer entrance permit, you complete the required entry into the abutting public sewer system, have the septic tank pumped and removed or filled with a non buoyant material.

Reinspections will be conducted to ensure compliance.

Should you be aggrieved by this order, you have the right to request a hearing before the Board of Health. A request must be received in writing in this office of the Board of Health within seven (7) days of receipt of this order. At said hearing you will be given the opportunity to be heard and to present witnesses and documentary evidence as to why this order should be modified or withdrawn. You may be represented by an attorney.
