d) A Filing and Inspection Fee of \$ 150.00, plus an Entrance Fee of \$ _____ where applicable, must accompany this application.

e) Other requirements: INSP ONLY - ACE ASPHALT DO TO ALL WORK -

To be connected to a 10" Sewer Line at E. of STREET - 330 GPD.

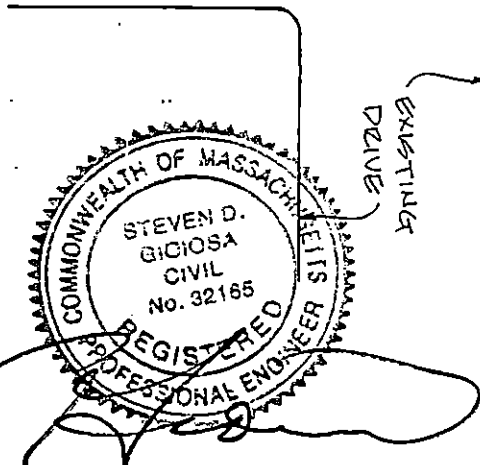
