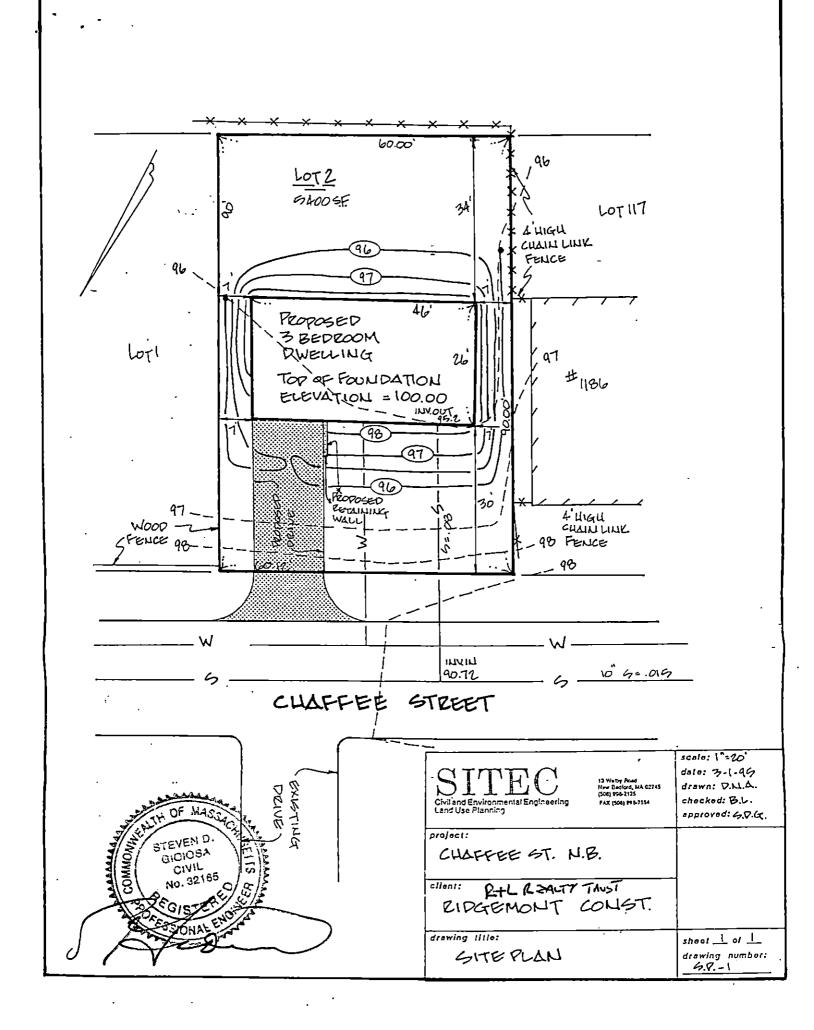

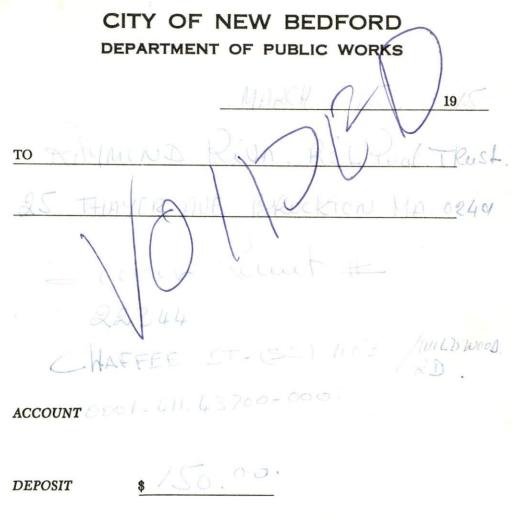
Easterly by the southerly line of Chaffee Street sixty and 00/100 (60.00') feet; thence
