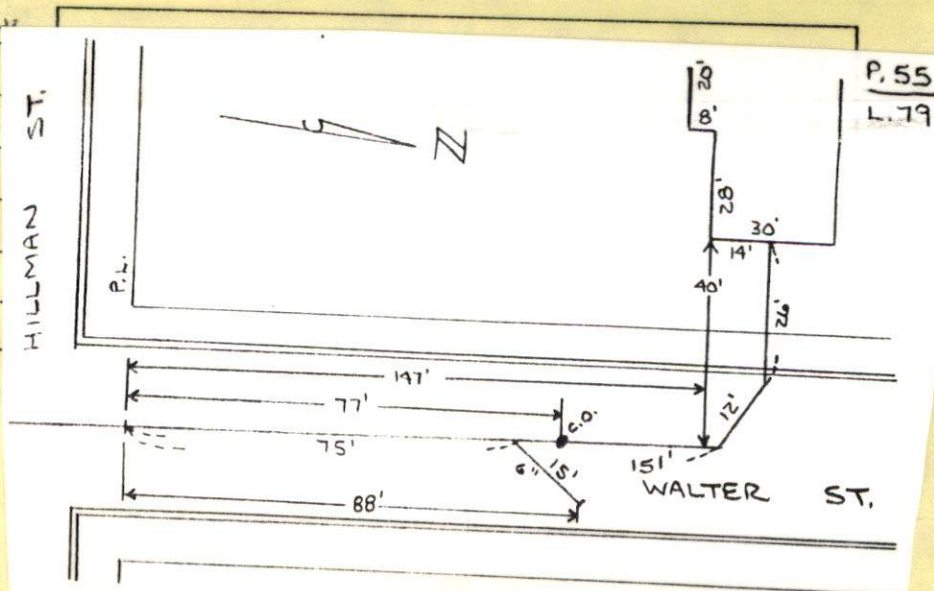

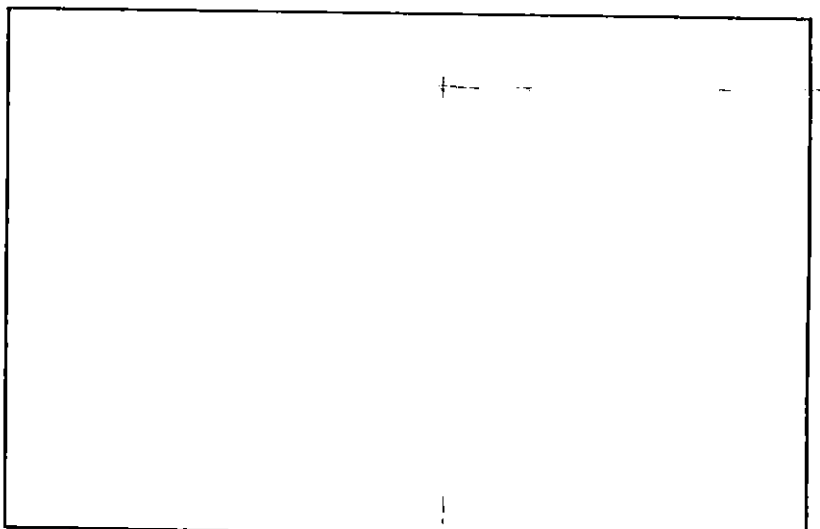

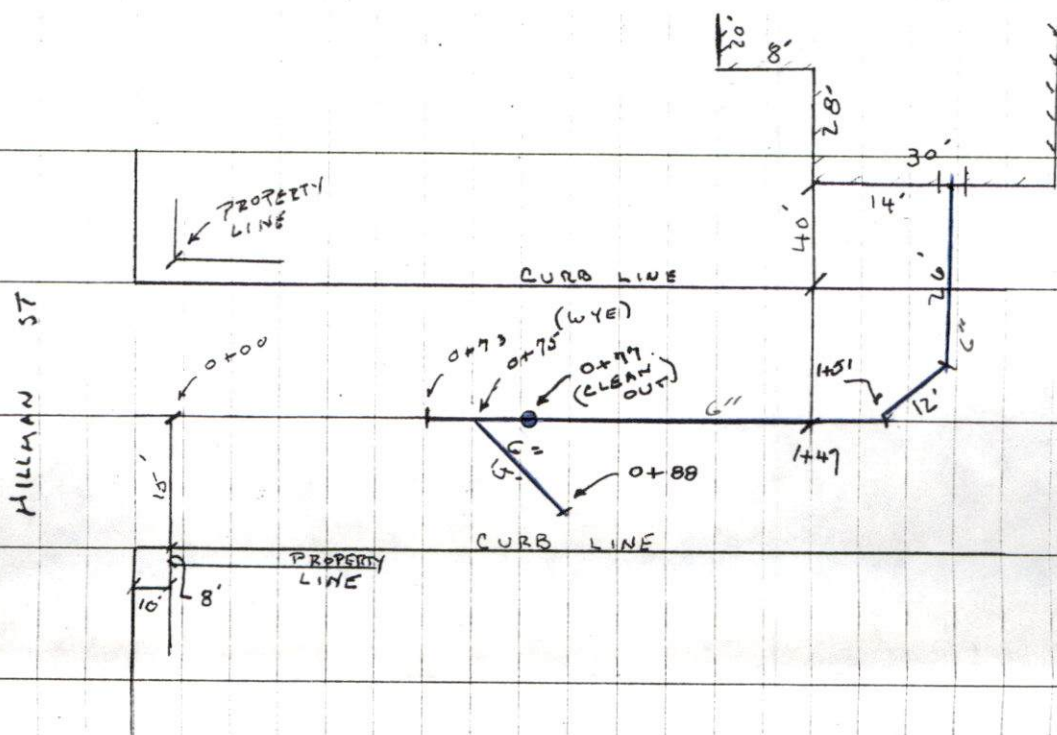


SKETCH PLAN

Re: Recommended Utilities in private Walter Street

A foundation permit has been issued to construct a single family home at the end of private Walter Street. The lot is the last developable parcel on Walter Street and presently has no water, drainage or sewer service. I have spoken with the owner of the lot, who will be building a single family home by himself, for he and his family, and I would like to help him answer several questions. They are:

1. What size water line will be required to service this one home? ~~6 inch~~
2. Will a meter pit be required at Hillman Street? *NO*
3. Will a hydrant be required at the end of the line? Closest hydrant is in front of #485 Hillman Street.
4. What size sewer pipe will be required? Can he tie into the existing 6" line *PVC PIPE* servicing #2 Walter Street under Permit #22544? Will a joint maintenance agreement be required?
5. Will a manhole be required in Walter Street? If so, where? *NO, CLEARED OUT*
