

SKETCH PLAN


drain plat 211 - no pipe size for sewer

I aim proposing a French drain be installed at the property owned by Mr. and Mrs. Glen Warrington known as Plot-136 Lot-444, foundation permit # 368204, Sewer and/or Strom Drain Permit #23607.

I have made a copy of the engineers plan and drawn on it. The red line around the house is the perimeter drains to catch the roof water runoff. This also shows the proposed 5'+5' dug hole filled with stone for the water to go into.

It is my recommendation that this be done because.

- 1. From the lowest point in the back it would be an estimated 8' down at the curb.
- 2. From there it has to go across the street which would make it even deeper.

I would appreciate any input or recommendation you could give me regarding this situation.
