The estimate for the sewer installation at **969 Stratford St.** is **\$ 5,600.** If she decides to have the City do the work - she will need to come in to sign a "Notification of Charges" and we require 1/3 deposit. The remainder will be billed upon completion.

She can speak to Carol Days as far as a payment plan for the balance (we usually allow them to stretch the balance over a 12 month period)
