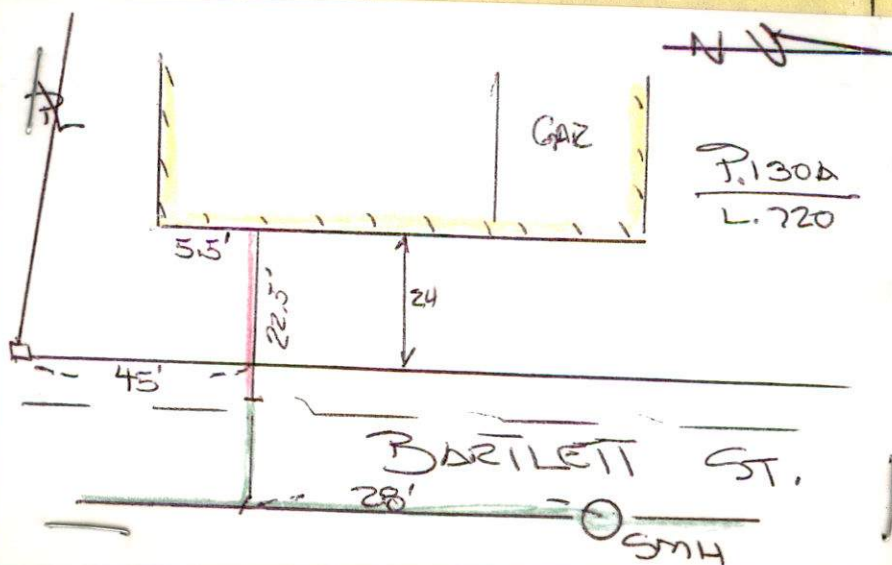

Dear Mr. Nichols:

The above permit for foundation recently came before the Department of Public Infrastructure for review. Based on the review done by our Engineering Division, the site plan presently in the View Permit system (being called "Site Plan of Land") dated November 16, 2015 was approved by this department.

One of the conditions of our approval was that the owner/developer consult with the Planning Department and record a plan at the Registry of Deeds creating the layout lines for the proposed right-of-way as shown on this submitted site plan.

After the right-of-way lines have been legally established via recording of a plan, if the intent is to ultimately make this portion of proposed street into a public way, then the street must also go through the Street Acceptance process. Being constructed to City requirements for acceptance does not automatically make it a public way, and it does have to be submitted to City Council for acceptance.

Please be advised that these issues need to be resolved prior to our review for issuance of the Certificate of Occupancy. Kindly contact Mr. Manuel Silva, Supervising Civil Engineer, at 508-979-1550 with questions and for any assistance you may require.
