

Application for Laying Water Main on Total Cost Basis

July 27, 2000

To the New Bedford Water Board:

I, the undersigned, hereby make application for the laying of an 8" water main in **Roland Street**, from Raymond St. westerly to a terminus with a hydrant a distance of approximately 110 feet..

It is agreed that the total cost of performing this work shall be bourne by me.

The above described extension shall be made by my contractor according to the specifications of the New Bedford Water Department and is estimated by him to cost \$7500.00.

It is further understood and agreed that upon application for service from this proposed line of main pipe as described herein, the applicant shall pay the cost of installing the service line from the water main into the property of the applicant within 30 days from the laying of said service line. The Board reserves the right to approve or reject any or all petitions, for the best interest of the City.

The above application has this day been approved by a majority vote of the New Bedford Water Board subject to the terms herein specified.
