

I, Rick Miller, property owner of 20 Howard Ave (Assessors Plot 116, Lot 94) would like to build a loading dock and understand that there is an existing fire hydrant and 4-inch water service (permit #31718) for the building that requires relocating. The configuration of the fire supply and domestic service lateral is creating a problem to continue with this project. We would like to eliminate the hydrant because the building is equipped already with an 8-inch fire supply line (permit #31828) and an internal sprinkler system. Please accept this letter as acknowledgement that from this date forward, I take full responsibility and ownership of the existing 6-inch line, tapped off the 8-inch water main on Howard Ave, running easterly that feeds my building's 4-inch domestic water service.
