Dear Mr. Labelle:

Please allow this letter to memorialize our meeting of September 28, 2004 relative to Reis Asphalt, Inc. ("Reis").

On or about March 31, 2004 and April 15, 2004, the City of New Bedford issued street obstruction permits for work to be performed by Reis at 1060 Rockdale Avenue and 4661 Acushnet Avenue, respectively. Both projects were completed by Reis and inspected by the appropriate City authority.

Subsequently, on or about May, 2004, you notified Reis that the aforementioned work was not in compliance with applicable building codes, to wit: the water and sewer lines were located in the same trench. The City consequently revoked Reis's bond and/or its ability to obtain construction-related permits in New Bedford.

At our September 28, 2004 meeting, I informed you that, to the extent Reis may not have complied with applicable building codes, such noncompliance was unintentional and based on what Reis believed to be customary practice in the City. Nevertheless, Reis is now fully cognizant of the City's expectations and fully intends to comply with all relevant building codes on a going-forward basis.

Based upon our meeting and the resulting agreement, Reis has agreed that within thirty (30) days, it will relocate the water line (but not the sewer line) to the 1060 Rockdale Avenue property. In turn, the City has agreed to reinstate Reis's bond and allow it to once again obtain permits required in the course of its business. No other reparations for work already performed by Reis shall be required, including any work relative to the 4661 Acushnet Avenue property.
